NEW BUSINESS

New plantings recommended for common area dwarf pintas, or perennials like croutons. Many enjoyed the impatiens and brightened the association, though they are not long living annuals.

No parking of cars on grass across at 7751 34th ct.

Drainage issues discussed for ditch on Tropiflora property. It is Maple Lakes job to take care of ditch with permission from Tropiflora if we wish to see less flooding in Maple Lakes. We need to keep our eyes on it and work to clear drainage if water standing or backing up.

FPL paint electrical boxes suggested from Gary LaMotte. Boxes to be identified and FPL to be contacted.

It was agreed Reserves are for an emergency (damage to common areas) and new fence allocation. Three quotes needed. There is no determination of when new fence will be purchased.

A 1 year CD of \$5,000 was approved to be deposited at 5/3 bank at 2% for one year term. Cheryl will take care of this and may need assistance signature of President Connolly.

Lorida at end of 33rd complained of flooding in ditch. Work needed to clean up drain.

Sale Oct. 27, 28 starts at 8 am each day and likely will run until about 2 PM.

Joseph Ganey and Treasurer Cheryl Kessen will work on actual and proposed budgets 2018/2019 to be delivered sometime in December.
